What if #14: Ragged Flap Study

And so it hit me, **what if** ? I leave the flaps of the cuts for holes and fold them back, and tack them so they become a frame for the hole. Halos.

leaving flaps on reverse applique what if #14 indigo cutting patterns.

7	8	9

Process:

1. draw shape
2. draw cutlines
3. outline shape with back stitches to tack
4. cut, fold flaps back
5. outline flaps in tiny back stitch, thread matching color.
6. brush lightly with toothbrush to raise edges

test: } 7. machine wash
8. hot dryer with softner sheet + towel for abrasion
