

Fussy tearing stripes



Playing with prints is nice, but I like the yarn dyed woven patterns as well. what's nice is that yarn dyes can be torn along pattern lines to isolate color areas. You always get a straight line. Stripes work particularly well. And it is a great way to recycle old men's shirts into new designs.



Mixing stripes in a basic woven block can yield many great patchwork patterns.

Notice the existing cloth waste around you and use it to create new cloth.
