

Shaped weaving

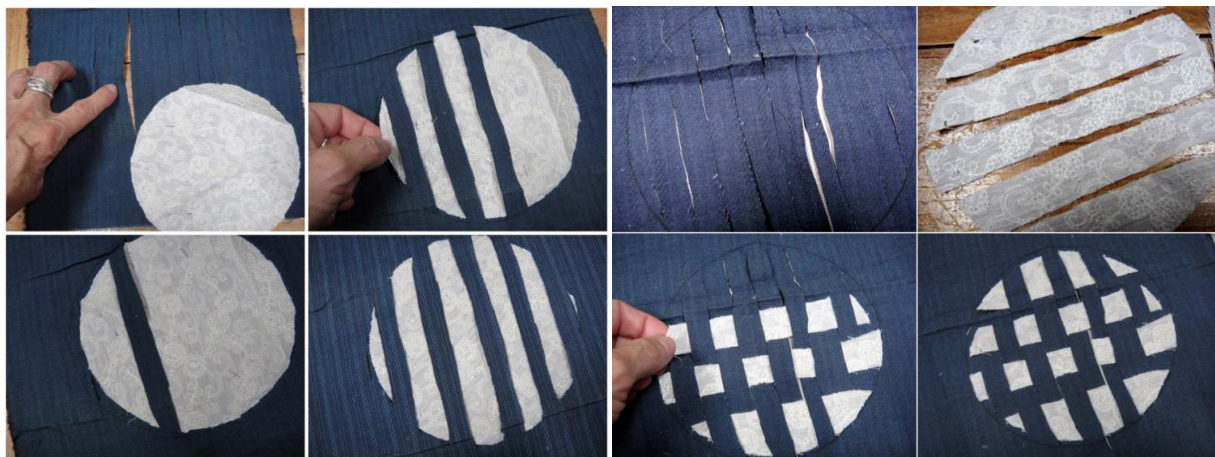
Method 1 - The Cutout and the Mask



The first and most obvious is the **cut out**. This method supports any shape. Work with any free form or anchored woven piece you have previously created or made especially for the cutout purpose. Of course as soon as you make a cut out, the next obvious choice occurs almost instantaneously. The **mask**. The mask is instantly created from the leftovers, from the shape you have just cut out. Both pieces can be used to create shapes in your work. And no waste!
